**A STATE-OF-THE-SCIENCE PROCEDURE:** From the convenience of your home, office, or laptop computer, watch William M. Keane, MD, and Marc R. Rosen, MD, use an advanced, image-guided, outpatient procedure to remove obstructions in the sinuses of a patient who experiences chronic sinus infections. This stereotactic surgery improves the results of sinus surgery and the safety of this increasingly popular endoscopic approach.

**LEADERS IN THEIR FIELD:** Jefferson's ENT surgeons have advanced the use of, and helped refine, endoscopic sinus surgery. They train others in their field in this procedure and are helping to make image-guidance a standard of care for endoscopic sinus surgery.
